Dear Neighbors,



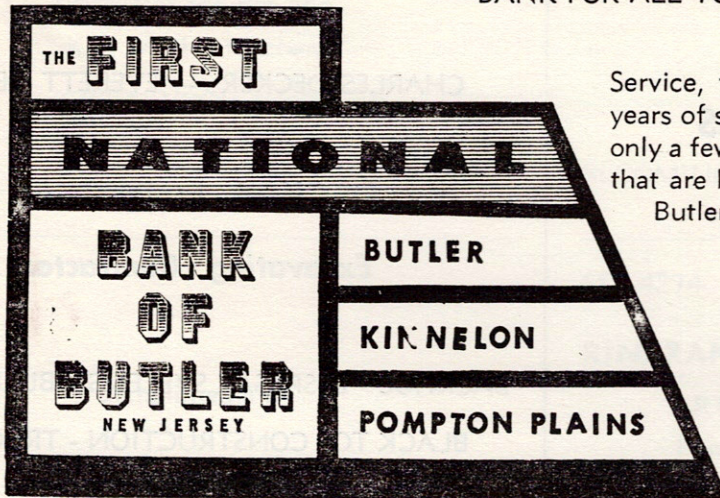

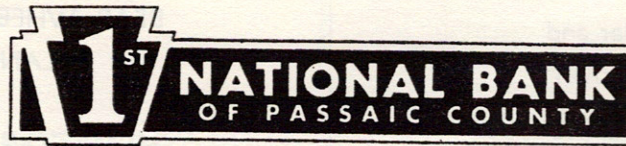
