Lindy's Lake - Then and Now

In 1927 the late George Spinnler purchased the farmlands of Charles and Gilbert Speaker and the Lindy's Lake Corporation came into existence. The residences of both Speaker brothers still exist. One is the home of Eileen and Tom Gill and the other, the farm house by the tennis court, is owned by the Association. Anxious to develop the spring-fed swamps into a lake, he mapped out his future community, offering the orchard portion (Highview and Lakeview Drives) for \$100 per 50' x 120' lot. They sold rapidly, many only for speculation, but afforded him the capital needed to develop the lake-front property. Once the dam was constructed and the lake became a reality, in only a few years the little area grew into a thriving summer community.

By 1935 the residents felt the need to organize, to have supervised activities and to establish some form of communal governing body. A committee was appointed to formulate a constitution. One of the committee members was Fred Kochendorfer of Upsala Path. As a result, the Lindy's Lake Community Association was formed that year, with annual membership dues set at \$9.75. It was agreeable to the Corporation that the Association would take over the operation of the beach and would pay for the use of the Manor, tennis court and ballfield for the summer seasons. This arrangement existed for the next 35 years.

Last summer, following lengthy negotiations, with the acquisition of the lake, roads, Manor tract and several other properties, the old Community Association gave way to the present Lindy's Lake Association, Inc., a court-approved organization. New by-laws and constitution were formulated and accepted. The Association members are now the sole owners of Lindy's Lake. This dream became a reality through the persistence of a small dedicated group, supported by the majority of homeowners who gave an overwhelming show of confidence by their immediate financial backing for the property's purchase. The road has been both difficult and costly, but extremely rewarding, as this summer will be an historic one — the first at our OWN lake community.

ECOLOGICALLY SPEAKING...

We now own Lindy's Lake . . . the responsibility of our community's natural environment is now ours! It is our job to protect our investment (our "home") by keeping our community healthy, our lake alive, and the pollution level as low as we possibly can. This job depends upon the individual efforts of all of us working together. The Lindy's Lake Association is ready to set the standards and to enforce all necessary rules and regulations. And now it is up to every resident to take a good look around him and survey this natural environment we call Lindy's Lake.

One of our primary and most urgent concerns at present is our lake. Faulty or inadequate septic systems coupled with the rocky nature of our terrain and poor soil percolation are leading causes of pollution to our lake. The majority of our homes have systems that were constructed with summer use in mind. However, today, these same systems are being over-burdened in order to serve year-round residents with much larger water consumptions. If you suspect a problem we urge you to tend to it now before it leads to more pollution and even more money to repair later.

One program the Lindy's Lake Ecology Committee would like to initiate is a systematic dye testing of each septic system at the lake in order to pinpoint existing faulty systems and to avoid potential ones. This type of program would enable us to get to the crux of our pollution problem quickly. However, this type of program requires your individual cooperation and permission. Are we ready to face pollution at Lindy's Lake . . . or don't we really care?

Additional programs are also being enacted or studied by the Ecology Committee. They all require your support!

If each of us could take one step to insure and safeguard the natural potential of this area we would be able to create and maintain an alive, beautiful, healthy community we would all be proud of.

Remember, a community is but the reflection of the people who live there. . . .

LINDY'S LAKE ASSOCIATION, INC. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Only those people who are members of the Lindy's Lake Association, Inc. shall be permitted the use of the lake, beach, Manor, tennis court facilities, etc. year-round.
- 2. A member is one who: (a) has paid his annual dues, and (b) has contracted to purchase a \$500 membership bond in the Lindy's Lake Association, Inc.
- 3. All members, children and guests of members must wear their membership badges at all activities.
- 4. Membership badges are not to be loaned to resident non-members at any time.
- 5. Swimming areas are to be kept clear of boats and large rafts.
- 6. Glass bottles are not permitted on the beach at any time.
- 7. Pets are not allowed in the beach area at any time.
- 8. All members are expected to cooperate fully with our lifequards and counselor.
- 9. All residents are expected to avoid littering and dumping on private lots within the community.
- 10. All residents are requested to keep all garbage cans tightly covered and off the roadways.
- 11. Motorists and mini-bike riders are urged to drive slowly and carefully through all areas where children may be playing.
- 12. Dogs must be tied at all times and are not allowed to run loose in any area of the lake community.


